Thomas McCarville was born in 1720. His son, Thomas, born in 1750, married Mary Goddin. Their children were, Dennis born in 1783, who lived to be 100 years old, Felix, Patrick, and Bridget (who was married twice), Thomas Joseph and Michael.

The 5th child, Thomas Joseph McCarville was born in Newolis, near Clones, County Monaghan, Ireland in 1800. Thomas married Mary Jane McGuire (or MaGuire), a native of Ennis Killen, County Fermanagh, Ireland. They migrated to St. Alphonse, Canada and later to Darlington, Wisconsin. He was engaged in the butcher business and died in Darlington, WI in 1892. His wife, born in 1800 died in 1886.

The McGuires are recorded in history texts as Kings of Fermanagh Ireland down through the ages. Jane McGuire's mother was a Carrigan. Thomas Joseph's nephew, also named Thomas, son of the 100-year old Dennis, was a merchant sailor in New York and later lived in Darlington, WI.

Thomas Joseph McCarville and Jane McCarville are the common ancestors of the McCarville-Duffy clan. Their children were Barney, Hugh, Bridget, Margaret Ann, and Thomas McCarville. The latter was single and was last heard from over 40 years ago in Butte, Montana.
